

**BRIEF PROFILE

**Inception:** College of IT and Management Education (CIME) (Formerly Centre for IT Education), Bhubaneswar started functioning in the year 2000 as an educational institution under the Department of Information Technology, Govt. of Orissa. The main objectives of the institute were to offer quality education in the field of IT and Management and create and cater to the manpower needs of the upcoming industries in the state and the country. The institute then started full time MCA program in 2001 and later in 2005 added MBA program.

**As a Constituent College:** CIME has been taken over by Biju Patnaik University of Technology, Odisha (BPUT) as its third constituent college since February 2006. In accordance with the Statute of the University, the institute now runs under the direct control and supervision of the Vice Chancellor of the University. As such, the Board of Management of the University is the Board of Management of the CIME.

**Academic Programs:** CIME is today running two years MBA (2 years) and three years MCA (3 years) and MCA-LE (2 years) Programs with an annual intake of 120, 60 and 60 students respectively of its programs. Today, meritorious students find CIME as their preferred destination to pursue their career in IT and Management. The students get selected through Odisha Joint Entrance Examination (OJEE). Within a short span of fifteen years the institute has created a distinct image of its own in the field of MCA and MBA education in Odisha. This is particularly due its students and committed faculty members.

**Training and Placement:** The continuous training programs, industry-academic interactions, soft skill development activities carried out by CIME help students strengthen their core competencies and make them industry ready. A large number of pass outs of its MCA program are today placed in IT majors like Infosys, Satyam, Wipro, TCS, MindTree, Accenture, Iflex etc. Similarly, the pass outs of MBA students have successfully got into companies like ICICI Prudential, Reliance, Birla Sunlife, Wipro, Ambuja Cement, Cease fire, Hughes, Ranbaxy etc.

**Faculty and Faculty Development:** The core strength of CIME lies in its faculty members. All the faculty members have been selected through a process of selection by the University. CIME lays great emphasis on faculty development. On a regular basis, they are nominated to participate in the Faculty Development Programs at IITs, NITs and IIMs and upgrade their knowledge. All the faculty members are engaged in their research works for Ph. D and their works are at different stages of completion. The faculty members present articles at national and international conferences organized inside India and abroad. Many of the faculty members of CIME are also important members in various statutory committees of the University and Govt. bodies.

**Management Development Programs:** Besides the regular educational programs, the institute conducts various Teacher's Training Programs on a regular scale for the benefit of the teaching community as a whole. The BPUT has also identified CIME as its venue for the Management development programs.

**Industry interface:** CIME at regular interval invites eminent speakers from academia and high profile professionals from industries to interact with the students of the institution.

**Infrastructure:** The Institute is located in the midst of the Industrial estate of Bhubaneswar. It's sprawling campus, spic and span infrastructure, and over and above the student- teacher relationship provides a right kind of ambience for all-round development of its students. The library is well stocked with good collections of research journals, reports, latest edition books for the benefit of the students and teachers. The Computer Laboratory is also well equipped with modern facilities. The leased line connectivity is available round the clock to contribute to the emotional intelligence of the students of CIME. The BPUT and Govt. of Odisha have been providing necessary funds for continual upgradation of its infrastructure. The Institute does see a bright future for its students.

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
